MINUTE entry before the Honorable Manish S. Shah: No appearance on 11/21/24 is necessary. The motions to take discovery on Group 7 avoidance claims [1783] and [1785] are under advisement and will be addressed after Group 7 priority disputes are resolved. The court notes that, as with the Group 6 motions to take discovery, it is not inclined to authorize 90 days of discovery on avoidance issues. The parties have had years of access to their own internal records along with documents made available through the claims process and further factual development through formal discovery is not likely to be proportional to the needs of the case (primarily, the need to resolve this receivership sooner rather than later). Much of this case has been resolved with imperfect information, and avoidance claims likely should fare no differently. Notices Mailed. (psm,)
